CAMP RULES

- ✓ **Check-in 3:00-- Check -out time is 10:00am. Quiet hours must be respected between the hours of 10:00pm and 7:00am no loud music anytime. Use of generators is prohibited during quiet hours. Managers may make limited exceptions based on medical necessity.**
- ✓ **Children under the age of six (6) must be with adult at all times.**
- ✓ **Well Behaved Pets are Welcome.**
 1. **Dogs that bark excessively or demonstrate aggressive behavior are not permitted.**
 2. **Pets may not be left unattended.**
 3. **Must be on a leash and under control of their owners at all times.**
 4. **It is the owner's responsibility to clean up pet waste**
- ✓ **Vehicle --Must be parked on your own site. One per site. Additional parking must be arranged with the office.**
- ✓ **Campers/Sites Responsibilities:**
 1. **Fires- All fires must be kept in a fire ring and extinguished when unattended.**
 2. **Due to concerns associated with several invasive insects-OCWT does not allow outside sources of firewood. We have firewood available.**
- ✓ **Alcohol Policy: The following are Prohibited.**
 1. **Consuming an alcoholic beverage while operating a vehicle.**
 2. **Creating alcohol related disturbances within the campground**
- ✓ **The Following Are Prohibited:**
 1. **Draining waste water onto the ground.**
 2. **Firearms, air rifles, bow and arrows, and paint ball guns.**
 3. **Motorized bikes and ATVs.**
 4. **Disorderly conduct and profanity.**
- ✓ **The management of OCWT Reserves The Right to Revoke Or Terminate Any Permit For Violation Of any Rule. Management reserves the right to charge guest the cost of rectifying damage, caused by the deliberate, negligent, or reckless act of the guest to the campground property. Should this damage come to light after the guest has departed, we reserve the right to make a charge to the guest's credit/debit card, or send an invoice for the amount to the registered address.**
- ✓ **OCWT or Campground Director is not responsible for items lost or stolen, or damaged to the Permittee's property. Liability insurance is the responsibility of the Permittee.**
- ✓ **Permittee And All Persons or Guest In The Permittee's Group Assume All Risk And Responsibility For Personal Injury Or Death To Personal Property While On The Campgrounds. Permittee and all persons or guest in the permittee's group each agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless OCWT, its affiliates, employees and agents or the Campground Director and staff from and against any and all claims for death, bodily injury, destruction of property, losses cost, liens, liabilities, or expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees, court cost and disbursement) incurred by OCWT, its affiliates, employees or agents or the Campground Director and staff, arising in any way from the use of the campground facilities by the Permittee and all persons or guest in the Permittee's group.**

No Refunds Will Be Given If You Are Requested to Leave As A Result Of Violating Any Of The Campground Rules.

Please remember that you are in a campground, not on a horse ranch. All Equine waste must be cleaned up and deposited in the designated manure disposal sites. A charge of \$25.00 will be assessed if we have to clean the campsite, Keep the campground a safe place for all, so no rough riding or racing. No horseback riding after sundown.
